Treasurer's Report by Kathy: The Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented.

The Chief Operating Officer of BOA worked right along with Travis. The adjudicators were very pleased with our program. **This year's program:** We have completed 11 weeks of band, only 6 weeks left – we're past the half way point of the season. The students are seeing the rewards of their hard work. **Two DVD's** are in the works: 1) 30th Anniversary of FM Band's State Championship. 2) Aimed towards 8th graders and parents. **Atlanta:** We'll be performing sometime in the 5:30 – 6:30 time frame Friday PM. **Football seating** is changed because of safety. **8th grade** night turn out was great. **NFHS & FMHS:** the only positions know at this time are the principal and bookkeepers. **FUSION** program was discussed. Changes to the program are a good thing!

Committee Reports: Band Store by Judy: Web site has all items that are available for sale. **Fruit Sale** by Cathy: Coming soon! Sale dates are from Oct 13 through November 13. Delivery is the first week in December. We will be sorting the fruit. We need rollers to unload the boxes.
